More Ways To Save Energy

Here are steps you can take to help maximize energy savings over winter holiday.

- Save and secure. Shut exterior windows and doors to boost security and energy efficiency.
- Hit the switch. Turn off overhead and task lighting.
- Pull the plug. Turn off nonessential electronics such as coffeemakers, toasters, fans, printers, chargers and other devices.
- Clear the fridge. Empty refrigerators can be defrosted and left unplugged to save energy (be sure to leave the door open).
- Shut the sash. Lab users should close all fume hood sashes and power down nonessential lab equipment.
